Christy Stillwell writes fiction, essays, and poems. She lives in Bozeman with her family.

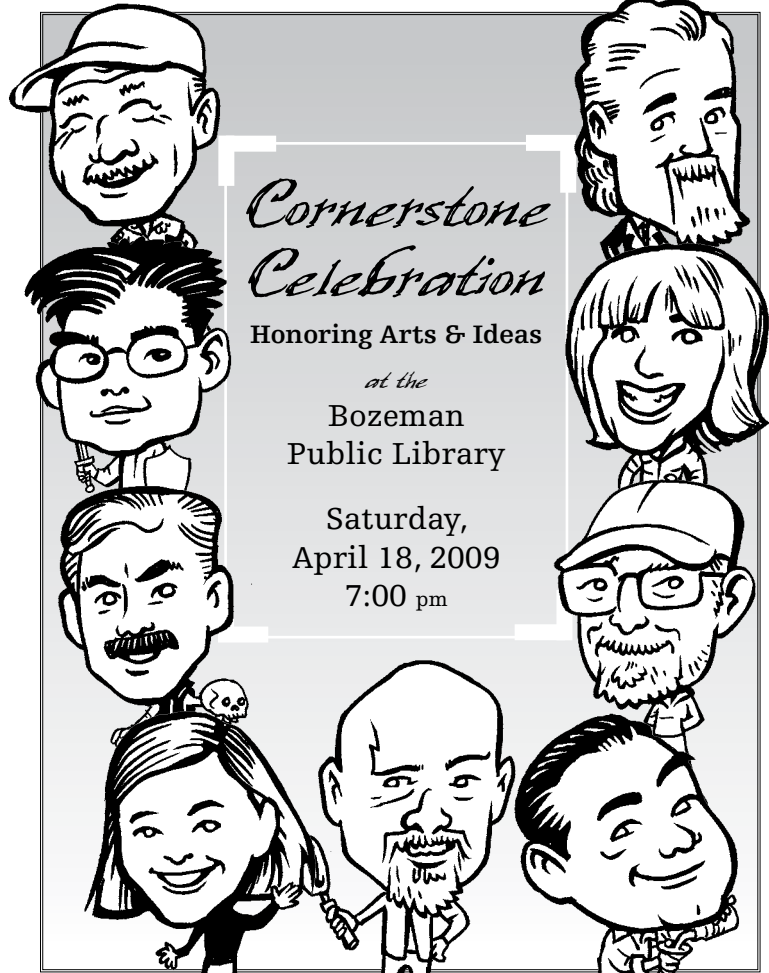

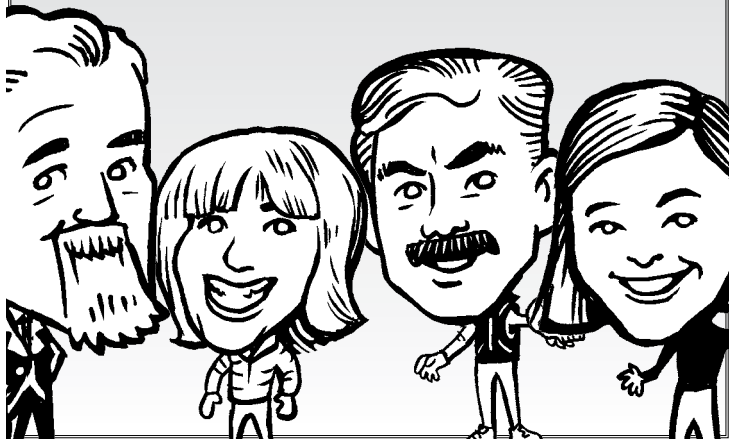
