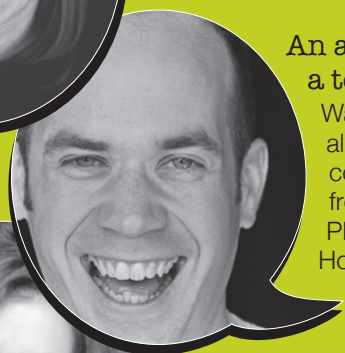
Have you heard the one about the world-traveler, acclaimed outdoor writer and author of very funny books?

You get Christy Stillwell! Her work has appeared in numerous literary magazines, and in 2008 she published *Amnesia*, a chapter book of poetry.



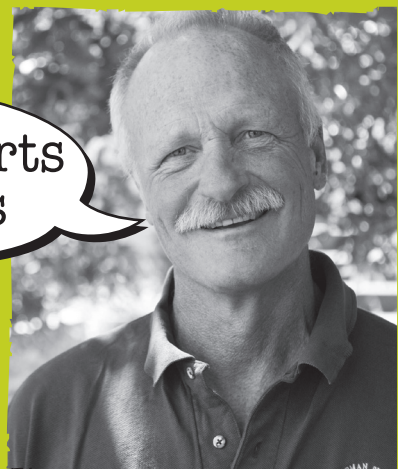
An actor, a playwright and a teacher walked into a bar....
